

Nicaragua – Mid July (possibly July 10-16 or 16-24)

Lodging/Travel/Food

Lodging – Hotel in Managua (2 nights) & Rio Blanco (6 nights)

Food – Prepared by Pablo & Hotel staff in Rio Blanco; out to eat in Managua

Air Travel – From Lexington to Managua

In-Country Travel – 15 passenger van from airport to Rio Blanco (4 hours). Van driver will be provided. Van will also be used for travel in Rio Blanco.

Ministry Sites

Requirements for Travel

Passport: It takes at least 4-6 weeks to process a passport. Fees to obtain a passport are \$100. Documents **needed when applying include: two passport photos, driver's license (Photo ID), front and back copies (must be on same page) of driver's license, original birth certificate, and complete form DS-11.**

- Routine Vaccinations: MMR and Tetanus
- Typhoid
- Malaria Pills
